

BRAUN STATION WEST - POOL RULES

Posted Pool Rules

Braun Station West pools are private pools for use by BSW property owners, residents, and their guests. To ensure everyone may safely enjoy the pools, some rules are necessary. The following is a list of the rules posted at each pool. **The posted rules must be observed at all times and the rules are to be strictly enforced by the lifeguards, the senior lifeguard, and the BSW Manager.**

1. **No tag --- No Swimming.**
2. No bottles or glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
3. No animals are allowed in the pool or pool area.
4. No running, pushing, or horseplay.
5. Bathing suits only (no cut-offs). Unseamed garments can unravel and threads can clog filters causing expensive repairs.
6. No profanity.
7. Parents assume responsibility for children in the wading pools.
8. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. Children ages 10 and 11 may swim without adult supervision provided they have passed a swimming proficiency test administered by the Lifeguard.
9. Guests: \$1.00 per day per person.

General Pool Rules

1. **Swim tags must be worn at all times.**
2. **Persons not wearing swim tags will not be allowed to enter or remain in the pool area (Guests excluded).**
3. A member may have a reasonable number of guests at the pool. The host/sponsor must be present at the pool with the guest(s) and the host is responsible for the guests' safety and conduct. All guests must register upon entering the pool area. The host/sponsor must pay \$1.00 for each guest they bring into the pool area.
4. The lifeguards are in charge of the pool and are responsible for swimmer safety and efficient operation of the pool.
5. The lifeguards, senior lifeguard, and BSW Manager have the authority to enforce the rules and to ban anyone from the pool for periods of time from 15 minutes to 3 to 6 days. The wading pools are for small children only, accompanied by their parents. When the wading pool is crowded, children over 6 years old should not use the wading pool. Small children left unattended in the wading pool by an adult will be asked to leave for their own safety.
6. No large toys, floats, or boats will be allowed in the water when the pool is crowded. Pool games will be restricted to one area of the pool when other swimmers are present.
7. Scuba diving using self-contained breathing apparatus is not allowed. The use of swim fins and snorkels is allowed.

8. No swimming after hours. The chemical balance is maintained only during those hours the pool is officially open.
9. No Smoking in the pool area.
