Dear BSW Resident,

Change is a fact of life. We can embrace it or fight it with every breath we take.

Your community's Board of Directors is asking that you embrace this change. The change being our city's new automated garbage and recycling system. Yes, each of us is now the proud owner of two LARGE receptacles that need to be stored somewhere. We are asking that you store them away from street view by placing them in your garage or behind your privacy fence.

The following paragraph, addressing this issue, is a policy statement for our community adopted by your board of directors. Let's make sure that we put our best face forward not only for our neighbors but for our visitors and potential home buyers as well.

The actual wording in our neighborhood Policy is: **“No cans, bags, containers or receptacles for the storing or disposal of trash, garbage, refuse, rubble or debris shall be stored, kept, placed or maintained on any lot where visible from any street except SOLELY on a day designated for removal of garbage and rubbish and on which days only such cans, bags, containers and receptacles may be placed in front of a residence and beside a street for removal, but SHALL BE REMOVED FROM VIEW BEFORE THE FOLLOWING DAY.”**
